THEMES

The theme of the 9th International Conference and Exhibition ON ARCHITECTURE 2021, entitled FACING THE FUTURE – NEW CHALLENGES, follows the basic concept realized and developed at previous conferences of a multidisciplinary approach to the topic of architecture.

The Association is keen that the papers presented at the Conference address themes of relevance to the reshaping the future and post-pandemic sustainability. Papers that fit within main topics of conference theme and areas of interest can be joined as introductory lectures.
