- Abstract (250 words maximum)

Second page

• Begin text (continuing onto further pages)

Last page

• Brief biography of the author(s): 100 words per author maximum please

The word " Photo " followed by the number of the figure should be followed by a brief caption and centered below the figure. For example:

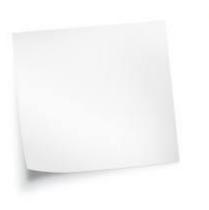
